

Type of Opportunity: Acupuncture**City:** College Park**State:** Maryland**Details:**

I have three needs at present in my clinic.

First, a bit about me. I am a 2006 acupuncture graduate, 2011 Chinese herb program graduate, and have taught in both acupuncture and Chinese herb programs (in the Chinese herb program I was a clinic supervisor). I hired a MUIH acupuncture student in 2013 to work for me as my admin assistant/front desk/insurance person, and she has since graduated and is practicing now in my clinic.

I have been practicing in Prince George's County for nearly 12 years, and have a very busy, successful practice. Currently there are three acupuncturists working (including myself). We also have a massage therapist, a somatic psychotherapist, and a MUIH-trained nutritionist working at the clinic. We are open 6 days a week, have a full herbal pharmacy on site and are swamped with new patient calls every week. Clinic is located in College Park, Maryland.

My current needs are as follows:

1. Part-time admin help. This is a GREAT opportunity for a student to learn the ins and outs of running a busy clinic. The learning opportunities are invaluable -- from discussions with working acupuncturists about chinese medicine to filling chinese herbal prescriptions for patients, to learning administration of a clinic and the insurance business side of things.

Flexible hours and truly exceptional working environment. Hourly pay, dependent on experience.

2. New acupuncturist addition to create a Community Clinic in our center.

This person would NOT be in network with insurance. Has to be Maryland licensed and desirous of treating multiple patients in a one-room setting.

This is an Independent contractor arrangement, and includes full service admin support (including online scheduling, promotion on our website and marketing materials, all supplies except needles). Flexible hours in consultation with me. This is an amazing opportunity for someone who wants to build a practice -- the sky's the limit here, depending on how busy one wants to be!! We turn away many people who do not have insurance coverage and cannot afford to pay out of pocket rates -- we already have a robust list of folks to contact to get the practice rolling. Not to mention the thousands of students in the neighborhood who would LOVE to be able to drop in for treatment.

3. Acupuncture Assistant. I have to have a full shoulder replacement soon, and need someone who can work with me for 4 to 6 weeks during my recovery while my arm is immobilized. I see 50+ patients a week currently, but looking to reduce this to 40-45 in the new year. My schedule is full January - March of 2018. I do not want to cancel all of these folks. What I need is a Maryland licensed acupuncturist to shadow me as I see patients, take notes and insert and remove needles at my instruction. This position is an amazing chance for a newly licensed practitioner to work with a seasoned professional seeing lots of different cases and observing me in action. I have performed close to 30,000 treatments in my career and love to teach and share what I have learned from my teachers and my many patients over the years. There is a possibility for the position to continue for up to 6 months, and indeed, for the right person, for them to join the practice and work independently at our center. This position will require 4 days per

week of work and I have not yet worked out how I will pay (hourly, or a fixed salary for the time period contracted), but it will be a paid position.

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
